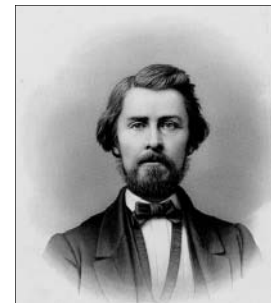
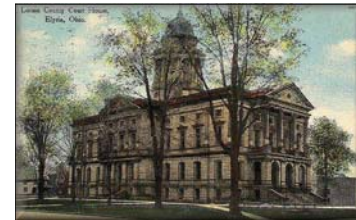

# LOCAL HISTORY AND GENEALOGY COLLECTION OF THE ELYRIA PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM

The Local History and Genealogy Collection of the Elyria Public Library System is located on the ground floor of the Central Library behind the Adult Services desk. The Collection is a result of the Daughters of the American Revolution having donated its extensive collection to the Library at the close of World War II and the addition in 1968 of all the Library's Ohio and local histories. Today, it includes over 2,000 volumes, plus manuscripts, periodicals, microfilm, and some photographs.

Items continue to be added to the Collection which can only be used in the Library. The Collection can be divided into two major areas—*History and Genealogy*, including Ohio and Lorain County.

The public is welcome to use the Collection during regular Library hours. The Collection's items may be accessed on public terminals or a Reference Librarian can answer specific questions, though extensive research cannot be expected. If you must leave the area temporarily, advise a Librarian or attach a note to the materials.

Photocopies from the copy machines are \$.10, while microfilm are \$.25 each. Free use of an electronic magnifying machine for the visually impaired is always available.

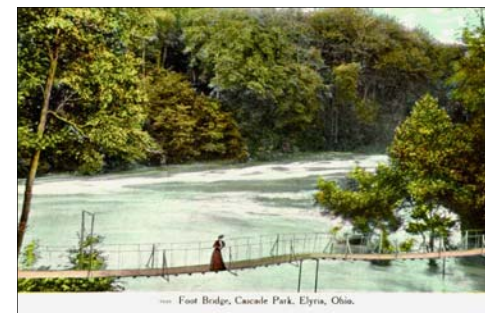
