Rodriguez, Jaclyn. *A Vow in Vengeance.* Romance/Fantasy. Each year, humans are forced to journey into the Immortal Realms, but twenty-year-old Rune orchestrates her own selection, determined to find her family and destroy anyone who stands in her way.

McAllister, Gillian. *Caller Unknown.* Thriller. Simone's holiday to Texas was meant to be some much-needed bonding time with her teenage daughter, Lucy. On their first night in the desert, Simone wakes to find Lucy missing and a mobile phone in her place. The phone Lucy has been taken and, to get her back, Simone must commit a crime.

Patterson, James & Dilallo, Susan. *The Invisible Woman.* Mystery. Elinor Gilbert is the Invisible Woman—but not the kind who can walk through walls.
